Training

We have held training at least once a week during our spring and autumn term. We have usually started from KTH Hallen, where we have had the opportunity to rent / borrow dressing rooms & showers.

For the fall, we tried with our best efforts to bring in new motivated and happy individuals. Under the circumstances with Corona, we think we have succeeded in a good way, despite the goal of paying members had to be reduced a bit. This is partly thanks to more joint activities during the fall. We had for example a training camp in beginning of November, as NSM was cancelled. We have also focused on social gathering after the trainings with FIKA, as long as we could meet together. This has been especially appreciated during last year as teaching has been done online and the physical meetings are set to minimum. The fall meeting had 20-30 participants, after which we had a traditional sausage barbecue.

Exercises have varied as far as possible between orientation, running, running strength intervals and endurance workouts. We have also done some exciting orienteering games both during our regular trainings as well as in the weekends. The goal has been to teach our members orienteering in a more encouraging and playful way. The orientation pass has mainly been located in Lill-Janskogen, although we have sometimes driven from other places.

Not to forget – We still enjoy the new revised map of Lill-Jansskogen now with updated paths, buildings etc. A big increase in joy for us as a small OL-Club!

Arrangement

We have adhered to the usual classic arrangements this year.

- We arranged the ÖL-OL during the autumn. It was good fun and a tradition that should be kept for the future.
- The camp in the archipelago during June was a good opportunity for all members to improve their orienteering skills as well as get together as a team. We were at Rånö over the weekend, lived in small cottages and managed to run around 4 orienteering courses.
- This year's Lusselöpet was popular and consisted of a Foxhunt, with a traditional food sharing / Lussefika afterwards. It was a successful event where we gave thanks for the semester and said goodbye to some exchange students as they moved on to new adventures.
- We attended Student Union Day at the beginning of the spring. We see that many are enthusiastic and curious about what orienteering is, especially international students. Many of them lack this opportunity for sports in their respective countries.

Competition

Our ambitious plan of competing got totally changed due to Corona. As all competitions in orienteering on an entry level were cancelled, we could just continue with our regular activities and focus on own events. During the year there were no regular competitions that KOT members attended to.
